



To All Rotary BBQ Participants:

It is time to make preparations for the Alvin Sunrise Rotary Club's 9th Annual BBQ Cook-off and Music Festival to be held March 27th - 29th, 2020. The location will be at Briscoe Park, 3625 Briscoe Drive, Alvin. **The cook-off will be IBCA sanctioned.**

Participants from the 2019 Cook-off who return their registration forms and fee prior to 3:30pm February 7th, 2020 will be guaranteed their choice of current spot on a first come, first serve basis. This year spots 120 to 160 are being moved to the football field where the kids' zone was located last year. If your team number falls in this category, you will be given first right of refusal to keep your same spot number or relocate. After February 7th, 2020 all spots will be available to other teams on a first come basis. The total space area is planned to accommodate approximately 200 teams.

The enclosed package includes the 2020 BBQ Cook-off Entry Forms (1 entry form for each spot requested), BBQ Cook-off Schedule of Events and ASRC Rules.

ASRC Contest Rules and IBCA Rules

1. Entries for the Bar-B-Que Cook-Off may be obtained either by calling or visiting TDEC, Inc. 911 South Gordon, Alvin. (281.331.3172), as well as www.alvinmusicfestival.com.
2. All cook-off teams will receive 3 wristbands. These cook wristbands designate those individuals who belong to your cook-off team. At 12:00 AM each day of the event, all persons not wearing a wristband are required to leave the cook-off area. General admission wristbands will be available for sale at the head cooks meeting.
3. Contestants for the Bar-B-Que Cook-Off will be those who have submitted the entry form with a \$300.00 entry fee and been approved as having satisfactorily met the Rules and Regulations governing the contest.
4. Date and time of application receipt to Terry Droege will be the basis for the participants picking the location of the cook-off space. Teams will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. (Contestants must be 18 years of age or older).
5. Any special entertainment (i.e. bands, promotions, skits, shows, demonstrations, contests, etc.) must be fully described in writing and submitted with the application for approval by Alvin Sunrise Rotary's Contest Committee. **No other bands or cook-off music may be played during any on-stage concert. We will issue one verbal warning. Upon subsequent violation team will be disqualified from the cookoff competition.**

6. Each contestant will be assigned a 30' wide by 30' deep cooking space.
7. Contestants must supply ALL needed equipment and supplies. The Alvin Sunrise Rotary Club furnishes the cooking site only. If you require electricity, each spot will get 1 outlet.
8. All contestants must check in and set up between 7:00am and dark on Thursday, March 26th and 7:00am to 11:00am Friday, March 27th. No contestants will be allowed to enter the contest area before 7:00am Thursday March 26th.
9. **All IBCA rules will apply.**
10. Teams cannot sell any Bar-B-Que and no to-go plates will be allowed.
11. Fires must be charcoal, wood or wood substance. Electric or gas fires will be allowed for optional categories in which foods need to be cooked in this manner. Contestants must take all precautions necessary to prevent fire hazards. All fires must be contained in a suitable manner. Contestants may be disqualified if precautionary measures are not followed or unsafe conditions exist. **Teams must carry a working fire extinguisher which displays a current inspection tag.**
12. Holes or dug pits are not permitted. Any equipment or devices that may damage the surface area of the contest site, in any way, are prohibited.
13. The Head Cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his team and guests. Misuse of alcoholic beverages and/or unacceptable conduct will be grounds of disqualification and forfeiture of awards. Glass beer bottles are not permitted in the contest area
14. Alvin Sunrise Rotary **WILL NOT** be responsible for theft or damage.
15. Props, trailers, motor homes, vehicles, tent coverings, or any other part of the contestant's equipment **MUST NOT EXCEED** the boundaries of the assigned cooking space unless approved by the Bar-B-Que Committee Chairman. (*Pat Burford*)
16. Contestants may drive two vehicles into the contest area for set up purposes only. After setup, all vehicles must be moved to the contestant parking area. The use of RVs and/or tents is permitted as long as they are contained within the team's cook-off site. Teams are not allowed to have any ATVs (3-wheelers, 4-wheelers, Gators, etc.) in the cook-off area at any time. **No vehicles will be allowed in the cook-off area after 11am on Friday, March 27th.**

17. It is the responsibility of the contestants to see that their respective areas are kept clean at all times, and that the cooking sites are cleaned and policed following the Bar-B-Que Cook-Off contest. Any space left in disarray or with unbounded trash or garbage will disqualify the contestant from future participation and awards. Area should look the same or better when you leave as when you arrived.
18. Trash receptacles will be provided and placed throughout the contest area for each contestant to use. Under no circumstances would the contestant have a receptacle within their assigned area for private use unless they have brought their own.
19. Judges will be chosen by IBCA rules.
20. Decisions of the Alvin Sunrise Rotary Club's Cook-Off Committee Chairman and the IBCA Judges will be final. Interpretation of these rules will be at the sole discretion of the Alvin Sunrise Rotary Club Cook-Off Committee.
21. **All Cook-Off areas must be cleaned and vacated on Sunday, March 29th. Cook teams will be able to move out starting at 2:00am until 11:00am Sunday morning. No moving will be allowed between 11am and the end of concert on Sunday. No personal alcohol will be allowed in the park on Sunday per TABC rules.**
22. **After 11am on Friday, March 27th no beer or ice will be allowed through the Gate. We will have beer for sale in the Beer Garden. Ice may be purchased from the Rotary Club. No vehicles will be allowed thru the gate after 11am on Friday, March 27th.**
